(A) JOB SPECIFICATION

1.0 SCHEDULE OF PRELIMINARIES

1.1 GENERAL

The Contractor shall carryout the works as detailed and or inferred in the Technical Specification comprising of Trade Schedules and Drawings which takes precedence over the Standard Specification, Part (B).

1.2 STANDARDS

All works shall be carried out to the accepted standard trade practices, Local Authority Regulations and the relevant PNG and Australian Standards.

1.3 NATURE OF CONTRACT

The contract will be Fixed Price Lump Sum Contract. Approved variations shall be paid for at the applicable rates listed in the Schedule of Rates for Variations.

1.4 LOCATION OF SITE

The work site is located on Section 12 Allotment 01 and 03 within the vicinity of PNG Power Office Building – Hohola. This fence runs along the boundary separating Allotment 01 (office building) and Allotment 03 (Staff Single Quarters).

1.5 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

All existing and damaged cyclone fencing to be demolished/removed and new spike fence to be constructed including painting works.

1.6 SITE INSPECTION

The Contractor shall inspect the site prior to lodging his Tender and satisfy himself with the nature of the site, PNG Power Ltd will not be liable if conditions proved otherwise climatic conditions and services relevant to the contract.

1.7 QUOTATION

The contractor after inspection shall provide his quotation and forward to Property and Accommodation Group – Property Development Team.

1.8 POSSESSION OF SITE

Possession of Site shall be on the date stated in the Letter of Acceptance to the successful tenderer.

The Contractor shall be given such possession of the site as is considered necessary to carry out these works, but such possession shall not be deemed to mean exclusive possession.

1.9 SITE OPERATIONS

1.9.1 Safety

All matters and conditions regarding safety, health and welfare of persons working on site shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.

1.9.2 Site Facilities

The Contractor shall arrange for and meet all the costs associated with the provisions of his electricity, telephone, water ablution facilities, temporary buildings for his workmen including site security.

1.10 PROJECT SUPERVISION

Any queries arising in relating to this contract shall be forwarded to Senior Property Development Officer and the PNG Power Inspector to be dealt with. All matters shall be resolved within a minimum of seven (7) days period.

1.11 CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

The Contractor shall provide a detailed construction schedule expanding on the Tender Construction Schedule within one (1) week or 7 days of acceptance of contract.

1.12 QUALTIY OF WORKMANSHIP

The contractor shall employ experienced and skilled welders, concrete block layers, plumbers and painters. The workers shall be supervised by a tradesman supervisor for all trade related work as PNG Power expects a high standard of workmanship when carrying out the work.

1.13 PAYMENT

Payment shall be made upon completion of all work and upon recommendation of the PNG Power inspector. Part payment shall be allowed in this contract. And the contractor must provide copies of receipts of materials purchased with part payment invoice including labor and transport cost.

1.14 USE OF SECOND HAND MATERIALS

No second hand materials shall be used unless indicated in the specification or shown on the drawing or until they have been inspected and approved by the Superintendent.

1.15 SETTING OUT

The works shall be located where indicated on the drawings, however, the accurate setting out and adherence to details of levels and squareness of the building will be the sole responsibility of the Contractor.

1.16 WORK COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION DATE

Upon receiving of this official order, the successful contractor shall liaise with the PNG Power Inspector to set commencement and the completion date. The works shall be Practically Completed within Six (6) weeks from the date of Possession of Site given in PNG Power's Letter of Acceptance.

The PNG Power Inspector shall ensure that the contractor must complete all work in the given period. However, if the contractor shall not meet the completion target date, then he shall inform the PNG Power Inspector one week in advance and must provide good reasons for doing so.

1.17 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Liquidated damages will be applied if the work is delayed for longer period without a proper written explanation to the Project Supervisor. A penalty will be calculated and forwarded to the contractor.

1.18 CLEANING UP

Upon completion of the works, the contractor shall leave the work areas clean and clear of rubbish, excavated material and access material which is of no use to PNG Power. All rubbish shall be dumped at the local authority's official garbage dump and not at or around the work site.

2.0 DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

2.1 MOBILISATION & SITE ESTABLISHMENTS

- 2.1.1 The Contractor shall organise and mobilise on site upon PPL instruction or upon receiving of PPL Official Purchase Order.
- 2.1.2 The contractor shall arrange for temporary services on site including site access, telephone, power and sewerage for use by its workers.
- 2.1.3 The Contractor shall arrange for storage spaces on site to store materials, tools and other plant and equipments.

2.2 EXCAVATION & DEMOLITION

- 2.2.1 Excavate 300mm x 300mm x 700mm deep holes as indicated on the drawing and shown on the plan.
- 2.2.2 Excavate 300mm x 300mm x 700mm deep holes as indicated on the drawing and shown on the plan.
- 2.2.3 Locate underground services and foundations before any excavation work commences. Make good at no extra cost damages to existing services.
- 2.2.4 Demolition of existing fence, fence posts and concrete footings shall be done as per indicated on drawings/plan.
- 2.2.5 Any demolition of part of nearby buildings or properties done outside of the scope, the cost shall be borne by the contractor.
- 2.2.6 Demolish or clear and any obstruction (ie; stonewall, trees, stumps etc) that is in the way of the construction line.

2.3 CONCRETE WORKS

The Contractor shall supply all required materials and install as per works required in this contract as per relevant standards.

- 2.3.1 All concrete shall have a minimum strength of 20 MPa.
- 2.3.2 All concrete mixing shall be by mechanically driven revolving drum.

Hand

mixing is <u>not</u> permitted unless approved by the Superintendent. Minimum mixing proportions shall be 3:2:1 with a maximum slump of 80mm.

2.3.3 All footings, slabs, reinforcing, formwork etc. shall be inspected by the Superintendent before commencement of mixing and placing of concrete.

2.4 METAL WORKS

The Contractor shall remove existing fencing materials and store them neatly in an appropriate storage area. All steel and associated materials used for this work shall be of higher grade. No second grade steel and other materials shall be used.

- 2.4.1 Remove the existing spike panels marked out on the plan.
- 2.4.2 External/Internal: Fabricate and install standard spike fencing. Install spike steel panels made of 25x25mm SHS at 150mm centres to all fencing frames as shown.
- 2.4.3 Provide and fix 75x75mm SHS spike steel at 2800 centres to all fencing frames to provide support between steel stumps.
- 2.4.4 Provide and fix 50x25mm SHS steel brace horizontally welded along the fence bay towards the top and bottom as well, install 50x25mm SHS brace as shown on the drawings.
- 2.4.5 Bars shall be continuous in length; and where bolts and nuts are used must have washers welded to each end to prevent bars from being pulled out.
- 2.4.6 Fabricate and install 1.5 metre pedestrian gate as shown on the drawing M112923-02.

2.5 PAINTING SPECIFICATION

2.5.1 Quality of Materials

The contractor shall supply all painting materials and store them neatly in an appropriate area free from dust, moisture or anything that may have an immediate effect on painting materials.

All materials used for this painting work shall be of higher grade. No second grade materials shall be used, if the contractor shall or may want to use second graded materials, the contractor must seek Inspector's approval.

2.5.2 Brand

The contractor shall supply materials such as, undercoat, turps, final coat etc, from the same Manufacturer. Mixtures of painting materials from different brand of manufactures shall not be allowed.

2.5.3 Under Coats

Use metal primer or similar approved type under coat that can quickly settled and dried shall be used. The Contractor shall apply 2 coats of under coats on new surfaces.

2.5.4 Final Coat

After completion of the sanding work to all painting surfaces, the contractor shall carry out the painting of the final two (2) coats. Colours shall be preferred by the PNG Power Supervisor.

2.5.5 Turpentine

The Contactor shall only use turpentine to wash paintbrushes or to soften paint so that paints are flexible and easy to use. Kerosene shall not be used when carrying out the painting work.

2.5.6 Painting of Steel

- a. The contractor shall use Taubmans paints or paints from approved supplier when carrying painting works.
- Do not apply under coat without the approval of the PNG Power Inspector.
- c. Any existing paint surface shall be cleaned and washed down properly with sugar soap or detergents prior to applying of any under coat.
- d. Apply masonry filler under coat for all masonary surfaces prior to painting of final coats.
- e. All rusted metal surface shall be cleaned and scraped off properly before the metal primer is applied.
- f. Colours scheme shall be provided by PNG Power Inspector.
- 9. New surfaces shall have 2 coats of under before applying of 2 final coats.

2.6 CLEANING UP

Upon completion of the works, the contractor shall leave the work areas clean and clear of rubbish and excess material which is of no use to PNG Power Ltd.

All rubbish shall be dumped at the Local Authority's official dump site and not at or around the work site.

The drawings form part of the Contract Documents and all notes on the drawings are considered to be part of the drawings and the Contract.
